TODAY' SPEAKER

Frank Middleton introduced our speaker, the Colorado Secretary of State, <u>Mike Coffman</u>. Mike served as an Infantryman in the U.S. Army and as an Infantry Officer in the U.S. Marine Corps. Always active in politics, he was elected to his present position in 2006.

Mike spoke to us about his experiences in Kuwait and Iraq; described the situation in Iraq; and, talked about the major issues he is confronting as Secretary of State.



Regarding Iraq, Mike related the problems resulting from the competing factions; Sunis, Shias, Kurds, Al-Quaida and terrorists from outside the country. He said the key remains to <u>produce a government that can maintain stability</u>.

As SecState his goal is to ensure the political process is fair and accountable to Colorado citizens. He talked of last year's voting problems in Denver and in other Counties and his "Election Watch Program" designed to correct these problems. What voting system to use; mail only, electronic, paper, etc. is still being debated.
