
Band. Looks like Bob might have a new instrument to experiment with at his next concert!

### Our Speaker

Our guest speaker today was Matt Arnold. Matt is currently the executive director and primary spokesman for the grassroots effort to restore accountability to Colorado's judiciary, Clear the Bench Colorado (<a href="http://www.clearthebenchcolorado.org/">http://www.clearthebenchcolorado.org/</a>). Matt launched the effort following the Colorado's Supreme Court's violation of the Colorado Constitution, citizen's rights under TABOR, and their duty to uphold the rule of law in the infamous "Mill Levy Tax Freeze."

Clear The Bench Colorado is a grassroots movement to hold Colorado's Supreme Court justices accountable to the Colorado Constitution and to the people of Colorado.

Since April 2009, Matt has tirelessly sought to educate Colorado voters of their right to demand accountability of even Supreme Court justices in the upcoming November 2010 retention elections, and is building the case for the statewide "NO" vote on retaining the four justices of the "Mullarkey Majority" that must seek voter approval in 2010.
